CLUES

Staufen is a peaceful town at the southern trunk of the Black Forest, not far from Freiburg, Germany. The town is a pedestrian zone. As you enter the town, there is public parking on your right. Park here and look up to your left. You will see vineyards and a ruined castle overlooking the town. Head towards the vineyard and follow the path counterclockwise to the top of the ruins. Go thru the iron gate of the castle and explore the ruins. When you are done, leave thru the iron gate, taking a left. Follow the path to the overlook with the benches in front of you. Facing the benches, looking down on Staufen, continue to the right on the path to, heading north. You will pass two more benches on your right. The trail will fork. Take the little path on the right going slightly up hill. You will see a wire gate in front of you. Hike up to the wire gate and look west along the castle wall. Stand with your left side next to the edge of the wall. Under the small tree and stumps, about 3 meters in from the path you will find the box hidden under some rocks. We hope that you have enjoyed this!
