City: Grasellenbach / Odenwald (close to Fürth im Odenwald)
Start: Parking area „Nibelungenhalle / Grasellenbach“
Difficulty: easy
Length: approx. 1.5 - 2.0 hours
Comment: Attention: The spring water should be not used for drinking because it is not fresh. The spring water is pipe water from an other place because the orign spring dried up !!

**CLUE**

From the parking area in Grasellenbach follow the hiking signs to the "Siegfriedsbrunnen". Deep in the forest you will reach the legendary spring who Hagen von Tronje has murdered Siegfried, according the Nibelungs legend.

From the "Siegfriedsbrunnen - Siegfriedsspring" with cross and mononen follow the hiking path "no. 6" approx. 80 steps uphill. If you reach the forest way turn right and continue the way approx. 60 steps to a bird house, on the left side of the way. On the right side you should see a destroyed tree. From this place walk to the direction 38° downhill to the large fir tree. On the fir trees foot you will find, hidden under a wooden disk the "Siegfriedsbrunnen - Letterbox", only a few steps from the forest way.

Stamp up, take a postcard / Contactpaper, put the Box back on the same place and hide with the wooden disk as found. Attention because of other hikers ! Thanks.
