

Letterbox "Khao Lak" (placed by divehiker in Feb 2016)

Ort: Khao Lak, Thailand
Startpunkt: Entrance Khao Lak Lamru Nationalpark
N08°37.577 E098°14.371



Difficulty: *

Terrain: *** A so called Nature Trail, a small path through the jungle, a little bit of climbing is involved. Sturdy shoes required, trainers will do.

Distance: about 2,5 km (about 2 h)

Equipment: Compass, Stamp, ink pad, bathing logs, sun protection and insect repellent

Entrance fee: 200 Baht/about 5€ per person (02/16)

Restaurant: Inside the Nationalpark

Please Note: Do not leave the path.
You do not have to cross a road.
The box is hidden outside the National Park.

Clue:

After passing the cashier's booth we go left in the direction "Beach"

The Nature Trail starts between these 2 signs:



Look for the numbers of the following stations on the right-hand sign and enter them into the three-digit box in the final section below.

Footprints Rocks Beach Lichen (in this sequence)

Enter the **Letter** below the left-hand signs into the one-digit box in the final section below.

Now we can put away the clue and walk the path all the way through the 10 stations to the end. Do not miss the view point between stations 3 and 4. On our way we will come to a very nice beach. From there we pass a little bridge to take the nature trail back up.

Final: At the end of the Nature Trail (here we can get an extra stamp print) we go all the way to the end and then we go

Steps in direction .

We climb on this big stone. From here we can reach over a wall and find the letterbox.



Way back:

We can use the same way back that we have come or we can go alongside the road, which is shorter and very interesting, too.

Tip:

Your entrance ticket is valid for the whole day. It gives you access to the Ton ChongFa Waterfall at the other end of Khao Lak, which is worth a visit.
