



## Le petit Mont Saint Michel

(placed Juli 2017 by WormserWanderWölfe)

**Location:** Bretagne, Cote d'Amor, Erquy

**Start:** Parking spot at the corner Rue Saint Michel and Route de Lormet

**Equipment:** compass, stamp, stamp pad and logbook

**Difficulty:** easy

**Terrain:** heavy; **Only accessible at low tide, the stone passage is otherwise flooded**

**Length:** approx. 2 km; 1.5 hours should be planned

### Infos:

Le Petit Mont Saint Michel ... so he is called really ... and unlike his big brother in Normandy, you can find here some silence. It lies off the main tourist routes, hidden behind the cliffs of the emerald coast, near the Cap d'Erquy. The tidal amplitude is here up to 14 m, you can hike it only at low tide.

### Clue:

Inform yourself at the parking spot about the accessibility to the island. The passage is only open for about 4 hours and the times change daily with the low tide.

Cross the stony passage carefully and climb up the chapel.

Look for the "map table". Aim from the table to a outstanding rock in about 300 ° and 17 cautious steps. From here you can see in 285 ° a larger stone plate. Look for a way there. The letterbox can be found in about 135 ° and 14 steps below a rock nose, hidden behind stones on the ground.

Be careful before other tourists, stamping off and hiding the box again well.
